

NEXT STEPS

Congratulations on your acceptance to Georgia State and welcome to **THE STATEWAY**. As an incoming **FIRST-YEAR, TRANSFER, TRANSIENT** or **POSTBACCALAUREATE** student, you'll need to complete the next steps listed below.

SET UP YOUR CAMPUSID, EMAIL AND WEB SERVICES

1. Set up your **CampusID**
You'll use your CampusID to log in to just about everything.
 - Look up your CampusID at webservices.gsu.edu/lookup.
 - Select **Activate New CampusID** at campusid.gsu.edu to get started.
2. Get **DUO**
Once you've activated your CampusID and username, download DUO to set up your mobile device or phone number for multifactor authentication. DUO helps ensure it's really you accessing your emails.

This must be completed BEFORE you set up your PantherMail student email account. Get started at technology.gsu.edu/duo.

3. Set up **PantherMail**
Get your Georgia State email address. You'll use this for communications with the university.
 - Go to PantherMail at technology.gsu.edu/panthermail.
4. Log in to Panther Access to Web Services (**PAWS**)
PAWS is your online portal to student accounts, housing, orientation and more.
 - Using your CampusID, log in to PAWS at paws.gsu.edu.
 - While you're there, check out the **New Students** section.

FILL OUT YOUR FAFSA

Your Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) application can also verify your citizenship.

Start your FAFSA application at fafsa.ed.gov.
(Georgia State's FAFSA Code is **001574**)

This application will determine if you're eligible for all federal and state aid programs. You're encouraged to submit a FAFSA, even if you think you're not eligible for federal aid programs, because this application will determine your eligibility for the HOPE Scholarship and other financial aid opportunities.

You must have a FSA ID to complete this application.

SUBMIT YOUR INTENT TO ENROLL

Complete the Intent to Enroll form so we know you're coming. No payment is necessary to complete your Intent to Enroll. You must view your acceptance letter in the **Status Update** tab before you'll have access to complete the Intent to Enroll form.

APPLY FOR HOUSING (optional)

The housing application will be made available in late January. Housing priority will be given on a first-come, first-served basis.

VERIFY LAWFUL PRESENCE

You must provide verification of lawful presence in the United States to receive in-state tuition.

To verify your lawful presence, follow the steps outlined at admissions.gsu.edu/lawful-presence.

SIGN UP FOR NEW STUDENT ORIENTATION

Our Start @ State modules are an efficient, virtual introduction to life at Georgia State. Once you complete Start @ State, you'll be prompted to register for a New Student Orientation session.

Remember: All first-year students are required to attend orientation. You'll meet with an adviser, make your schedule and connect with fellow Panthers.

REGISTER FOR PLACEMENT TESTS (if needed)

Log in to PAWS with your CampusID. Under the **Enrollment** tab, you'll see a menu in the left column. Register for each placement test by clicking each link individually. You're required to obtain your PantherCard and present it at the time of your test.

SUBMIT REQUIRED IMMUNIZATION

Immunizations are required for MMR, tetanus/diphtheria, varicella and hepatitis B. Fax the completed immunization form to 404-413-1955. If you'll be living in University Housing, you must also obtain the meningitis vaccine or sign an optional waiver from University Health Services. Visit health.gsu.edu for the waiver and include it with your housing application.

REVIEW FINANCIAL PACKAGE

Review your financial aid package under the **Financial Aid** tab in PAWS at paws.gsu.edu. You must accept/deny aid as needed. Check the remaining balance due and pay your bill by the deadline listed.

1. Show all credits and the date of your high school graduation. Submit an official college transcript if you attended another university or college through a dual-enrollment program.
